FOREWORD

This is the tenth annual register issued by the State Board of Accountancy of Kentucky. The purpose of this register is to furnish the general public with information regarding holders of Kentucky C. P. A. certificates, and Public Accountants registered to practice in this State. The 1946 Kentucky General Assembly enacted a law governing the practice of public accountancy entitled "The Public Accounting Act of 1946" which became effective on June 20, 1946. This law, among other things, requires that all persons, either Certified Public Accountants or non-certified public accountants, shall register with this Board and obtain a permit to engage in practice beginning July 1, 1946. Included as a part of this register is a copy of this Act and regulations promulgated thereunder, also, Rules of Professional Conduct, listing of Certified I blic Accountants and Public Accountants registered with the Board (alphabetically arranged) and a ling, arranged by cities, of all accounting firms (partnerships) practicing in this State.

PUBLIC ACCOUNTING ACT OF 1946

SEC. 2. BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY. THERE IS HEREBY CREATED A STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY IN AND FOR THE STATE OF KENTUCKY. The Board shall consist of three members, appointed by the Governor. Whenever an appointment is to be made the Kentucky Society of Certified Public Accountants shall submit to the Governor the names of three persons qualified for membership on the Board and the Governor shall appoint one of the three. Members of the Board shall be citizens of the United States and residents of this State who hold certified public accountant certificates issued under the laws of this State and who are in active practice as certified public accountants. The members of the Board first to be appointed shall hold office, one for one year, one for two years, and one for three years, from the effective date of this Act, the term of each to be designated by the Governor. Their successors shall be appointed for terms of three years. Vacancies occurring during a term shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term. Upon the expiration of his term of office a member shall continue to serve until his successor shall have been appointed and shall have qualified. The Governor shall remove from the Board any member whose permit to practice is not renewed or which has become void, revoked or suspended, and may, after hearing, remove any member of the Board for neglect of duty or other just cause.

The Board shall elect annually a president, a secretary and a treasurer from its members. The office of secretary and treasurer may be held by the same individual. The Board may adopt, and amend from time to time, regulations for the orderly conduct of its affairs and for the administration of this Act. The Board may also promulgate, and amend from time to time, rules of professional conduct appropriate to establish and maintain a high standard of integrity and dignity in the profession of public accounting. A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The Board shall have a seal which shall be judicially noticed. The Board shall keep records of its proceedings, and in any proceeding in court, civil or criminal, arising out of or founded upon any provision of this Act, copies of said records certified as correct under the seal of the Board shall be admissible in evidence as tending to prove the content of said records. The Board shall have printed and published for public distribution, in July of each year, an annual register which shall contain the names, arranged alphabetically by classifications, of all individuals and partnerships holding permits to practice under this Act; the names of the members of the Board; and such other matters as may be deemed proper by the Board. Copies of said registers shall be mailed to each registered practitioner. The Board may employ clerks and arrange for assistance in the performance of its duties.

Each member of the Board shall be paid ten dollars for each day spent in the discharge of his official

duties and shall be reimbursed for his actual and necessary expenses therein incurred.

All fees and other monies received by the Board pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be paid to the treasurer of the Board for the use of the Board, and shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of a revolving fund for the use of the Board. No part of this revolving fund shall revert to the general funds of this State. The compensation provided by this Act and all expenses incurred under this Act shall be paid from this revolving fund. No such compensation or expense shall be a charge against the general funds of this State. The Board shall file an annual report of its activities with the Governor, and such report shall include a statement of all receipts and disbursements.

SEC. 3. CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS. The certificate of "certified public accountant" shall be granted by the Board to any person (a) who is a citizen of the United States or who has duly declared his intention of becoming such citizen, and (b) who is a resident of this State or who has a place of business or is employed therein, and (c) who has attained the age of twenty-three years, and (d) who is of good moral

character, and (e) who is either:

(1) A graduate of a college or university recognized by the Board, and who has completed thirty or more semester hours or the equivalent thereof in the study of accounting, business law, economics and finance, of which at least twenty semester hours or the equivalent thereof shall be in the study of accounting, and who has been engaged in practice as a public accountant, or in the employ of a public accountant or of a certified public accountant for two years preceding the date of application, or

(2) A graduate of a college or university recognized by the Board, but who has not completed the hours of study and subjects specified in subdivision (1) of this section, and who has been engaged in practice as a public accountant, or in the employ of a public accountant or of a certified public accountant, for three

years preceding the date of application, or

(3) A graduate of a high school with a four-year course or who has had an equivalent education, and who has been in practice as a public accountant, or in the employ of a public accountant, or of a certified public accountant, for at least six years preceding the date of application, and (f) who shall have successfully passed a written examination in theory of accounts, in accounting practice in auditing, in commercial law as

affecting public accounting and in such other related subjects as the Board may deem advisable. Any person licensed to practice law in this State need not be examined with respect to such commercial law.

Examinations provided for herein shall be held by the Board as often as may be necessary in the opinion of the Board, but not less frequently than once each year. A candidate for the certificate of "certified public accountant" who fails in all subjects shall have the right to any number of re-examinations. A candidate who passes a satisfactory examination in any subject shall have the right to be re-examined in the remaining subjects only, at subsequent examinations held by the Board, and if he passes in the remaining subjects within a period of time specified in the rules of the Board, he shall be considered to have passed the examination. The Board shall charge each candidate a fee of \$25 for the initial examination. This fee shall be payable by the candidate at the time of making application for examination. Should the candidate fail to pass the examination, re-examinations will be given the same candidate for an additional fee of \$10 for each examination irrespective of the number of subjects therein covered.

Any individual who has received from the Board a certificate of "certified public accountant" and who holds an annual permit to practice issued under sec. 8 of this Act shall be styled and known as a "certified public accountant" and may also use the abbreviation "CPA." The Board shall keep a list of certified public accountants. Any certified public accountant may also be known as a "public accountant."

Individuals who at the time of the enactment of this Act held certified public accountant certificates heretofore issued under the laws of this State shall not be required to secure additional certificates under this Act, but shall otherwise be subject to all its provisions; and such certificates heretofore issued shall, for all purposes, be considered certificates issued under this Act and subject to all of its provisions.

The Board may in its discretion waive the examination of, and may issue a certificate as "certified public accountant" to, any person possessing the other qualifications mentioned in this section who is the holder of a certificate as certified public accountant issued under the laws of any state.

SEC. 4. REGISTRATION OF FOREIGN ACCOUNTANTS. The Board may, in its discretion, permit the registration of any person of good moral character who is the holder of a certificate, license, or degree authorizing him to practice public accounting in a foreign country. A person so registered shall use only the title under which he is generally known in his own country, followed by the name of the country from which he received his certificate, license or degree.

SEC. 5. PARTNERSHIPS COMPOSED OF CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS - REGISTRA-TION THEREOF. A partnership engaged in this State in the practice of public accounting may register with the Board as a partnership of certified public accountants provided it meets all of the following requirements:

(a) At least one general partner thereof must be a certified public accountant of this State in good standing, and

(b) Each partner thereof personally engaged within this State in the practice of public accounting as a member thereof must be a certified public accountant of this State in good standing, and

(c) Each partner thereof must be a certified public accountant of some state in good standing, and

(d) Each resident manager in charge of an office of the firm in this State must be a certified public accountant of this State in good standing. Application for such registration must be made upon the affidavit of a general partner of such partnership who is a certified public accountant of this State in good standing. The Board shall in each case determine whether the applicant partnership is eligible for registration. A partnership which is so registered and which holds a permit issued under sec 8 of this Act may use the words "certified public accountants" or the abbreviation "CPA's" in connection with its partnership name. Notification shall be given the Board, within one month. after the admission to or withdrawal of a partner from any partnership so registered.

SEC. 6. PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS-REGISTRATION THEREOF. Any person (a) who is a resident of this State or has a place of business. or is employed therein, and (b) who has attained the age of twentyone years, and (c) who is of good moral character, and (d) who meets the requirements of subdivision (1) or (2) or (3) of this section, may register as a public accountant with the Board on or before the first day of July, 1946.

(1) Persons who held themselves out to the public as public accountants and who were engaged within this State at the effective date of this Act in the practice of public accounting as their principal occupation.

(2) Staff accountants employed by certified public accountants or by public accountants and regularly

assigned to accounting engagements at the effective date of this Act.

(3) Persons serving in the armed forces of the United States or any of the United Nations who immediately prior to entering such service held themselves out to the public as public accountants and were engaged in the practice of public accounting as their principal occupation, or who were employed as staff accountants by certified public accountants or by public accountants and regularly assigned to accounting engagements. In the case of any such person serving in the armed forces of the United States or any of the United Nations on the effective date of this Act, the time for registration shall be extended for a period of twelve months from the time such person is honorably discharged from such service.

The board shall in each case determine whether the applicant is eligible for registration. Any individual who is so registered and who holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act shall be styled and known as a "public accountant."

- SEC 7. PARTNERSHIPS COMPOSED OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS—REGISTRATION THEREOF. A partnership engaged in this State in the practice of public accounting may register with the Board as a partnership of public accountants provided it meets all of the following requirements:
- (a) At least one general partner thereof must be a certified public accountant or a public accountant of this State in good standing, and
- (b) Each partner thereof personally engaged within this State and in the practice of public accounting as a member thereof must be a certified public accountant or a public accountant of this State in good standing, and
- (c) Each resident manager in charge of an office or a firm in this State must be a certified public accountant or a public accountant of this State in good standing. Application for such registration must be made upon the affidavit of a general partner of such partnership who holds a permit to practice in this State as a certified public accountant or as a public accountant. The Board shall in each case determine whether the applicant partnership is eligible for registration. A partnership which is so registered and which holds a partnership permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act may use the words "public accountants" in connection with its partnership name. Notification shall be given the Board, within one month, after the admission to or withdrawal of a partner from any partnership so registered.
- SEC. 8 ANNUAL PERMITS TO PRACTICE. Permits to engage in the practice of public accounting in this State shall be issued by the Board to holders of a certificate of "certified public accountant" issued under sec. 3 of this Act and to individuals and partnerships registered under sections 4, 5, 6, and 7 of this Act. There shall be a fee of \$10.00 for the original permit. All permits shall expire on the 1st day of July of each year, but may, annually, be renewed for a period of one year, by certificate holders and registrants in good standing upon the payment of an annual renewal fee of \$5.00. Failure to renew a permit before expiration thereof shall not deprive a certificate holder or a registrant of the right to renewal, in such cases a renewal fee of \$10.00 shall be paid
- SEC. 9. REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF CERTIFICATE, OR REGISTRATION, OR PERMIT. After notice and hearing as provided in sec. 11 of this Act, the Board may revoke or suspend any certificate issued under sec. 3 of this Act, or any registration granted under sec. 6 of this Act, or may revoke, suspend or refuse to renew any permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act, or may censure the holder of any such permit, for any one or any combination of the following causes:
- (a) Fraud or deceit in obtaining a certificate as certified public accountant, or in obtaining registration under this Act, or in obtaining a permit to practice public accounting under this Act.
 - (b) Dishonesty, fraud or negligence in the practice of public accounting.
 - (c) Violation of any of the provisions of sec. 13 of this Act.
- (d) Repeated violation of a rule of professional conduct promulgated by the Board under the authority granted by this Act, after warning by the Board that such continued violation will constitute grounds for proceedings hereunder.
 - (e) Conviction of a felony under the laws of any state or of the United States.
- (f) Conviction of any crime, an essential element of which is dishonesty or fraud, under the laws of any state or of the United States.
- (g) Cancellation, revocation, suspension, or refusal to renew the authority to practice as a certified public accountant or a public accountant in any state.
 - (h) Suspension or revocation of the right to practice before any state or federal agency or court.
- (i) Failure to become a citizen of the United States within six years by any person not a citizen of the United States when he received a certificate as certified public accountant under this Act.
- SEC. 10. REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF PARTNERSHIP REGISTRATION OR PERMIT. After notice and hearing as provided in sec. 11 of this Act the Board shall revoke the registration and permit to practice of a partnership if at any time it does not have all the qualifications prescribed by the section of this Act under which it qualified for registration.

After notice and hearing as provided in sec. 11 of this Act the Board may revoke or suspend the registration or may revoke, suspend or refuse to renew the permit to practice of a partnership or may censure the holder of any such permit for any of the causes enumerated in sec. 9, and for the following additional causes:

- (a) The revocation or suspension of the certificate or registration or the revocation or suspension or refusal to renew the permit to practice of any partner
- (b) The cancellation, revocation, suspension or refusal to renew the authority of the partnership or any partner thereof to practice public accounting in any other state.

- SEC. 11. HEARING BEFORE BOARD—NOTICE—PROCEDURE—REVIEW. (a) Commencement of Proceeding. The Board may initiate proceedings under this Act either on its own motion or on the complaint of any person.
- (b) Notice-Service and Contents. A written notice stating with reasonable particularity the nature of the charge and such acts of professional misconduct as are complained of against the accused and the time and place of the hearing before the Board on such charges shall be served on the accused not less than 30 days prior to the date of the hearing either personally or by mailing a copy thereof by registered mail to the address of the accused last known to the Board.
- (c) Failure to Appear If, after having been served with the notice of hearing as provided for herein, the accused fails to appear at said hearing, the Board may hear evidence against him and may enter such order as shall be justified by the evidence, which order shall be final unless he petitions for a review thereof as provided herein: Provided, however, that within 30 days from the date of any order, upon a showing of good cause for failing to appear, the Board may reopen said proceedings and may permit the accused to submit evidence in his behalf.
- (d) Counsel—Witnesses—Cross-examination. At any hearing the accused may appear in person or by counsel, produce evidence and witnesses on his own behalf, cross-examine witnesses, and examine such evidence and documents as may be produced against him. The accused shall be entitled, on application to the Board, to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses on his behalf.
- (e) Subpoenas—Oaths. The Board, or any member thereof, may issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents, and may administer oaths, take testimony, hear proof and receive exhibits in evidence in connection with or at the hearing under this Act. In case of disobedience to a subpoena the Board may invoke the aid of the Franklin Circuit Court. Any order or subpoena of such court requiring the attendance and testimony of witnesses and the production of documentary evidence may be enforced and shall be valid anywhere in this state.
 - (f) Evidence The Board shall not be bound by technical rules of evidence.
- (g) Record. A stenographic record of the hearing shall be kept and a transcript thereof filed with the Board.
- (h) Attorney for the Board. At all hearings the Attorney General of this State, or one of his assistants designated by him shall appear and represent the Board.
 - (i) Decision. The decision of the Board shall be by majority vote thereof.
- (j) Review by Court. Any person adversely affected by any order of the Board may obtain a review thereof by filing a written petition for review with the Franklin Circuit Court within 60 days after the entry of said order. The petition shall state the grounds upon which the review is asked and shall pray that the order of the Board be modified or set aside in whole or in part. A copy of such petition shall be forthwith served upon any member of the Board and thereupon the Board shall certify and file in the Court a transcript of the record upon which the order complained of was entered. The case shall then be tried de novo on the record but the parties shall be permitted to file briefs. The Court may affirm, modify or set aside the Board's order in whole or in part, or may remand the case to the Board for further evidence, and may in its discretion, stay the effect of the Board's order pending its determination of the case. The Court's order shall have the force and effect of decree in equity and may be appealed from the Court of Appeals.
- SEC. 12. REINSTATEMENT. The Board may reissue the certificate of any certified public accountant whose certificate shall have been revoked, or may permit the re-registration of any person whose registration has been revoked, or may reissue or modify the suspension of any permit to practice accounting which has been revoked or suspended.
- SEC. 13. ACTS DECLARED UNLAWFUL. (a) No person shall assume or use the title or designation "certified public accountant" or the abbreviation "CPA" or any other title, designation, words, letters, abbreviation, sign, card, or device tending to indicate that such person is a certified public accountant, unless such person has received a certificate as a certified public accountant under sec. 3 of this Act and holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended, provided, however, that a foreign accountant who has registered under the provisions of sec. 4 of this Act, and who holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act, and which has not been revoked or suspended, may use the title under which he is generally known in his own country, followed by the name of the country from which he received his certificate, license or degree.
- (b) No partnership shall assume or use the title or designation "certified public accountants" or the abbreviation "CPA's" or any other title, designation, words, letters, abbreviation, sign, card or device tending to indicate that such partnership is composed of certified public accountants unless such partnership is registered as a partnership of certified public accountants under sec. 5 of this Act and holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended.
- (c) No individual shall assume or use the title or designation "public accountant" or any other title, designation, words, letters, abbreviation, sign, card, or device tending to indicate that such person is a public

accountant, unless such person is registered as a public accountant under sec. 6 of this Act and holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended, or unless such person has received a certificate as a certified public accountant under sec. 3 of this Act and holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended.

- (d) No partnership shall assume or use the title or designation "public accountants" or any other title, designation, words, letters, abbreviation, sign, card, or device tending to indicate that such partnership is composed of public accountants, unless such partnership is registered as a partnership of public accountants under sec. 7 of this Act or as a partnership of certified public accountants under sec. 5 of this Act and holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended.
- (e) No individual, partnership or corporation shall assume or use the title or designation "certified accountant," "chartered accountant," "enrolled accountant," "licensed accountant," "registered accountant," or any other title or designation likely to be confused with "certified public accountant" and "public accountant," or any of the abbreviations "CA," "PA," "EA," "RA," or "LA," or similar abbreviations likely to be confused with "CPA," provided, however that a foreign accountant who has registered under the provisions of sec. 4 of this Act, and who holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended, may use the title under which he is generally known in his own country, followed by the name of the country from which he received his certificate, license or degree.
- (f) No individual shall affix his signature, with any wording indicating that he is an accountant or auditor, or with any wording indicating that he has expert knowledge in accounting or auditing, to any accounting or financial statement, or to any opinion on, report on or certificate to any accounting or financial statement, unless he holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended, provided, however, that the provisions of this subsection shall not prohibit any officer, employee, partner or principal of any organization from affixing his signature to any statement or report in reference to the financial affairs of said organization with any wording designating the position, title, or office which he holds in said organization, nor shall the provisions of this subsection prohibit any act of a public official or public employee in the performance of his duties as such.
- (g) No individual shall sign or affix a partnership name, with any wording indicating that it is a partnership composed of accountants or auditors or persons having expert knowledge in accounting or auditing, to any accounting or financial statement, or to any report on or certificate to any accounting or financial statement, unless the partnership holds a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act which has not been revoked or suspended.
- (h) No individual shall sign or affix a corporate name, with any wording indicating that it is a corporation performing services as accountants or auditors or composed of accountants or auditors or persons having expert knowledge in accounting or auditing, to any accounting or financial statement, or to any report on or certificate to any accounting or financial statement.
- SEC. 14. EXCEPTIONS—ACTS NOT PROHIBITED. Nothing contained in this Act shall prohibit any individual not a certified public accountant or public accountant from serving as an employe of, or an assistant to, a certified public accountant or public accountant or partnership composed of certified public accountants or public accountants holding a permit to practice under sec. 8 of this Act; provided that such employee or assistant shall not issue any accounting or financial statement over his name.

Nothing contained in this Act shall prohibit a certified public accountant or a registered public accountant of another state, or any accountant of a foreign country holding a certificate, degree or license which permits him to practice therein, from temporarily practicing in this state on professional business incident to his regular practice.

- SEC. 15. INJUNCTION AGAINST UNLAWFUL ACT. Whenever in the judgment of the Board any person has engaged, or is about to engage, in any acts or practices which constitute, or will constitute, a violation of sec. 13 of this Act, the Board may make application to the Franklin Circuit Court for an order enjoining such acts or practices, and upon a showing by the Board that such person has engaged, or is about to engage, in any such acts or practices, an injunction, restraining order, or such other as may be appropriate shall be granted by such court. The same shall be enforceable and shall be valid anywhere in this state and shall be reviewable as provided in the code of Civil Practice in the case of other injunctions and restraining orders.
- SEC. 16. MISDEMEANORS—PENALTY. Any person who violates any provision of sec. 13 of this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars, or to imprisonment for not more than one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment. Whenever the Board has reason to believe that any person is liable to punishment under this section it may certify the facts to the Attorney General of this State, who may, in his discretion, cause appropriate proceedings to be brought.
- SEC. 17. SINGLE ACT EVIDENCE OF PRACTICE. The display or uttering by a person of a card, sign, advertisement or other printed, engraved or written instrument or device, bearing a person's name in

conjunction with the words "certified public accountant" or any abbreviation thereof, or "public accountant" shall be prima facie evidence in any action brought under sec. 15 or sec. 16 of this Act that the person whose name is so displayed, caused or procured the display or uttering of such card, sign, advertisement or other printed, engraved or written instrument or device, and that such person is holding himself or itself out to be a certified public accountant or a public accountant holding a permit to practice under sec. 8 of this Act. In any such action evidence of the commission of a single act prohibited by this Act shall be sufficient to justify an injunction or a conviction without evidence of a general course of conduct.

SEC. 18. OWNERSHIP OF ACCOUNTANTS' WORKING PAPERS. All statements, records, schedules, working papers, and memoranda made by a certified public accountant or public accountant incident to or in the course of professional service to clients by such certified public accountant or public accountant, except reports submitted by a certified public accountant or public accountant to a client, shall be and remain the property of such certified public accountant or public accountant, in the absence of an express agreement between the certified public accountant or public accountant and the client to the contrary.

SEC. 19. EXEMPTION FROM JURY SERVICE. An individual holding a permit issued under sec. 8 of this Act shall be exempt from service on any jury.

SEC. 20. PRIVILEGED COMMUNICATION. A certified public accountant or public accountant shall not be required by any court to divulge information or evidence which has been obtained by him in his confidential capacity as such.

SEC. 21. DEFINITIONS. (1) Board—The term "Board" when used in this Act means the "State Board of Accountancy" created by sec. 2 of this Act.

(2) State—The term "state" when used in this Act includes and means any state, territory or insular possession of the United States, or the District of Columbia.

SEC. 22. CONSTRUCTION. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Act and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SEC. 23. REPEAL PROVISIONS. Sections 325.010 to 325.990 both inclusive of Kentucky Revised Statutes and all other acts or parts of acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed: Provided, however, that nothing in this Act contained shall invalidate or affect any action taken under any law in effect prior to the effective date hereof, nor shall invalidate or affect any proceeding instituted under such law before the effective date hereof.

REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY OF KENTUCKY

Pursuant to the authority of Section 2 of the Public Accounting Act of 1946 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") the following rules and regulations are promulgated—

1. APPLICATIONS

Application for certificate as a Certified Public Accountant by examination under Section 3 of the Act must be made on the form prescribed by the Board, and signed and sworn to by the applicant before a Notary Public.

The application must be in the hands of the State Board of Accountancy of Kentucky at least thirty days prior to date of examination.

The application must be accompanied by a certified check or money order for twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) payable to the "State Board of Accountancy of Kentucky." If the applicant fails to pass in one or more subjects he may sit for re-examination in such failed subjects by payment of \$10 for each re-examination.

It shall be the duty of the applicant to familiarize himself with the provisions of the Act before answering any questions in the application. A copy of the Act will be supplied with each application blank.

Each applicant shall cause to be filed with the Board five letters from persons to whom he is well known, and each such letter shall state an opinion as to the moral character of the applicant, and the fitness of the applicant to practice as a Certified Public Accountant. At least two of said letters shall be from officers or directors of a bank. These letters shall be mailed by the writers thereof directly to the State Board of Accountancy. The applicant shall state in his application the name and address of each person from whom such letters are to be received by the Board.

No applicant shall submit for reference the name of any person who is related to him by blood or marriage.

Each applicant must file with his application for certificate his photograph, taken within two years preceding the date of his application.

2. QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS

In order to be eligible to take the examination for a certificate as a Certified Public Accountant an applicant must—

- (1) Be a citizen of the United States—or a person who has, in good faith, declared his intention of becoming such citizen (offering written evidence in support of this fact).
- (2) Be a resident of this State, or have a place of business or be employed therein.
- (3) Be not less than twenty-three (23) years of age.
- (4) Be of good moral character, and be either—
 - (a) A graduate of a college or university recognized by the Board, and who has completed thirty or more semester hours or the equivalent thereof in the study of accounting, business law, economics and finance, of which at least twenty semester hours or the equivalent thereof shall be in the study of accounting, and who has been engaged in practice as a public accountant, or in the employ of a public accountant or of a certified public accountant for two years preceding the date of application, or
 - (b) A graduate of a college or university recognized by the Board, but who has not completed the hours of study and subjects specified in (a) above, and who has been engaged in practice as a public accountant, or in the employ of a public accountant or of a certified public accountant, for three years preceding the date of application, or
 - (c) A graduate of a high school with a four-year course or who has had an equivalent education, and who has been in practice as a public accountant, or in the employ of a public accountant, or a certified public accountant, for at least six years preceding the date of application.
- (5) Evidence of scholastic record attained by the applicant applying under either (a), (b) or (c) must be submitted with the application and remain a part thereof. Consideration will be given meritorious cases, individually considered, by applicants who have graduated from commercial schools having less than a four year course but have attained the equivalent of the semester hours required by clause (a) above in that such graduation and semester hours may operate to reduce the required experience in clause (b) to not less than two years and in clause (c) to not less than four years, as the case may be.

3. TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATIONS

At least once, and when practicable twice, each year the Board will conduct an examination for qualified applicants who have received written acceptance of their application to sit for the examination. The accepted applicants will be notified in writing to the address stated in their application of the exact place of the examination, dates, and hours each subject will be given. Unless otherwise determined these examinations will be held in the City of Louisville, Ky.

REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY OF KENTUCKY—(Continued)

4. EXAMINATION PAPERS

All examinations shall be written in pencil or in ink on paper provided by the Board. The examination papers may not be taken away and shall remain the property of the Board. All examination papers shall be preserved for a period of one year after each examination.

5. CONDUCT OF EXAMINATIONS

Applicants for examination shall be given a card bearing a number and the card shall be placed in a sealed envelope and handed to the examiners at the close of the first subject given in the examination. The number is for identification only and shall be used on all papers submitted by the applicant. If any applicant shall sign his name or write his initials or other identification marks upon his examination papers, such action shall be considered as misconduct and shall be sufficient cause for rejecting his papers.

6. EXAMINATION SUBJECTS

Examinations will include questions or problems on the following subjects:

- 1. Practical Problems
- 2. Accounting Theory
- 3. Auditing
- 4. Commercial Law

The applicant will be required to make a grade of not less than 75% in each subject before he will be granted a certificate. If any applicant fails to make the required grade in one or more of the subjects he may take the next examination on the subjects in which he failed, and if he attains the required 75% in all subjects the Board will then issue to him a certificate. Failure to pass any one or more of the required subjects will not operate to subject the applicant to sit again for any subject in which he has previously passed; provided however, that the credit standing in his name for previously passed subjects shall not remain for a period in excess of five years, unless such applicant has continuously sat for the examinations.

Any person licensed to practice law in this State need not be examined in the subject of Commercial Law.

7. FEES FOR EXAMINATION

The statutory fee for the examination is \$25.00, payable to the STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY OF KENTUCKY in the form of certified check, draft or money order. The fee must accompany the application. If illness or other condition beyond the control of the applicant shall prevent him from attending the examination, then his fee may be refunded.

8. APPLICANTS MUST CONFORM TO RULES

The act of filing an application for examinations shall be deemed to be and shall constitute an agreement upon the part of the applicant that he will observe and conform to the requirements expressed in these rules, or such as may be promulgated hereafter.

9. QUORUM—GRANTING OF CERTIFICATES

Two members of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of all business including the granting of, or recommendation for the granting of, a certificate to any person to practice as a Certified Public Accountant.

10. RECIPROCAL CERTIFICATES

The Kentucky Board has no specific reciprocal relations with Boards of any other States. Sub-paragraph 3 of Section 3, of the Act provides for the issuance of certificates by reciprocity to holders of C. P. A. certificates issued by other States. The Board will consider applications for a certificate by reciprocity only from residents of the State of Kentucky, or persons who are actually practicing accountancy in Kentucky. The discretion of the Board shall determine the qualifications of the foregoing. The application shall be made on a form prescribed and furnished by the Board and all the requirements hereinbefore set out for applicants shall be met, and, in addition thereto, the applicant shall request of the Board of his resident State a letter signed by the Secretary of such Board that the applicant is in good standing and holds unrevoked certificate number—— issued as a result of having passed a written examination conducted by that Board and the letter shall be mailed directly to the State Board of Accountancy of Kentucky.

OFFICIAL CODE OF ETHICS

RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

Preface: The "Public Accounting Act of 1946" is designed to regulate the practice of Public Accountancy in the State of Kentucky, and in adopting rules of professional conduct the words "Public Accountant" shall apply to Certified Public Accountants as well as to non-certified Public Accountants.

Recognizing that a clear concept of the obligations of all Public Accountants to their profession, to each other, and to the public is essential to a strong profession, and to the public benefit, the STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY OF KENTUCKY promulgates the following RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT:

(Malpractice)

(1) A public accountant shall not allow any person to practice in his name, or in the name of the partnership of which he is a member, unless such person is in partnership with him or in his employ.

(Participation in Fees)

(2) Commissions, brokerage or other participation in the fees or profits of professional work shall not be allowed directly or indirectly to the laity by a public accountant. Commissions, brokerage or other participation in the fees, charges or profits of work recommended or turned over to the laity incident to services for clients shall not be accepted directly or indirectly by a public accountant.

(Inconsistent Occupation)

(3) A public accountant shall not engage in any business or occupation conjointly with that of a public accountant which is incompatible or inconsistent therewith.

(Misconduct as to Expressing Opinion on

Financial Statements)

- (4) In expressing an opinion on representations in financial statements which he has examined a public accountant shall be held guilty of gross negligence or misconduct in the practice of public accountancy if:
 - (a) He fails to disclose a material fact known to him which is not disclosed in the financial statements, but disclosure of which is necessary to make the financial statements not misleading; or
 - (b) He fails to report any material misstatement known to him to appear in the financial statements; or
 - (c) He is grossly negligent in the conduct of his examination or in making his report thereon; or
 - (d) He fails to acquire sufficient information to warrant expression of any opinion, or his exceptions are sufficiently material to negative the expression of an opinion; or
 - (e) He fails to direct attention to any material departure from generally accepted accounting principles or to disclose any material omission of generally accepted auditing procedure applicable in the circumstances.

(Examination of Statements)

(5) A public accountant shall not sign a report, nor permit a report to be signed in his name, purporting to express his opinion as to the result of examination of financial statements, or verify any other forms of accountancy work, unless such statements or work has been examined by him, or by a member or an employee of his firm.

(Solicitation)

(6) A public accountant shall not directly or indirectly solicit the clients or encroach upon the practice of another public accountant, but it is the right of any public accountant to give proper service and advice to those asking such service or advice.

(Employment Ethics)

(7) Direct or indirect offer of employment shall not be made by a public accountant to an employee of another public accountant without first obtaining the consent of such other accountant. This rule shall not be construed to inhibit negotiations with any such employee who of his own initiative shall apply to a public accountant for employment.

(Contingent Fee)

(8) Professional services shall not be rendered or offered for a fee which shall be contingent upon the findings or results of such service. This rule does not apply to cases involving federal, state or other taxes, in which the findings are those of the tax authorities and not those of the accountant. Fees to be fixed by courts or other public authorities, which are therefore of an indeterminate amount at the time when an engagement is undertaken, are not regarded as contingent fees within the meaning of this rule.

(Advertising)

(9) A public accountant shall not advertise. A public accountant may authorize the listing in directories of his name, name of firm, address, telephone number, designation, Public Accountant or Certified Public Accountant to which he is otherwise entitled, membership in national and state organizations of Public Accountants or Certified Public Accountants provided that (a) no listing shall be purchased directly or indirectly except that a reasonable fee may be paid to list name or name of firm, address, and telephone number under appropriate occupational captions in classified telephone or city directories and (b) no listing shall be displayed in special type or form, or inserted under the caption for a locality not embracing his address, or otherwise designed to produce an effect of advertising.

(Restricted Affiliations)

(10) A public accountant shall not be an officer, director, stockholder, representative or agent of any corporation engaged in the practice of public accountancy in any state or territory of the United States or in the District of Columbia.

(Conjunctive Use of Name)

(11) A public accountant shall not permit his name to be used in conjunction with any estimate of earnings contingent upon future transactions in a manner which may lead to the belief that the public accountant vouches for the accuracy of the forecast.

(Expressing Opinion on Financial Statements)

(12) A public accountant shall not express his opinion on financial statements of any enterprise financed in whole or in part by public distribution of securities, if he is himself the actual or beneficial owner of a substantial financial interest in the enterprise or if he is committed to acquire such an interest; nor shall a public accountant express his opinion on financial statements which are used as a basis of credit, if he is himself the actual or beneficial owner of a substantial financial interest in the enterprise or if he is committed to acquire such interest, unless he discloses his financial interest in his report.

(Competitive Bidding)

(13) A public accountant shall not make a competitive bid for professional engagements in Kentucky, nor in any other state, territory, or the District of Columbia, if such a bid would constitute a violation of any rule of the recognized society of public accountants or the official board of accountancy in such other state, territory or district.

(Simultaneous Practice)

(14) A public accountant engaged simultaneously in the practice of public accounting and in another occupation must in both capacities observe these rules of professional conduct.

(Confidential Relationship Between Accountant

and Client)

(15) A public accountant shall not violate the confidential relationship between himself and his client.

WHAT IS A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT?

A statement issued by the Kentucky Society of Certified Public Accountants in pamphlet form.

A certified public accountant is one who has met the requirements of the particular state from which he received his certificate with respect to his character, training and experience. For the purpose of keeping himself up to date on current evolution and development in matters of accountancy, he usually finds it desirable to be a member of his local State Society of Certified Public Accountants and also of the American Institute of Accountants.

He offers his services to the public as one schooled in the interpretation of business transactions from a sound accounting viewpoint and one whose judgment with respect to the affairs of a particular company is not prejudicial by reason of financial or any other interest therein. In dealing with accounting matters relating to business transactions he is trained to be accurate, orderly, and systematic, and to analyze facts and figures.

Because of this he is frequently called to collaborate with business men in the making of plans and carrying them through and to advise and assist in matters of organization, reorganization and merging of businesses and corporations. He aims to help industry to conform to governmental regulations. He should be thoroughly familiar with Federal and state tax laws, social security legislation, wage and hour bills, method of accounting, and ways and means of reducing costs. He is alert in the discovery of discrepancies, intentional and otherwise, thus removing temptation from cashiers and other employees who handle money.

In the performance of his duties as auditor the certified public accountant represents himself as one who is proficient in accounting practice and auditing procedure. The function of the certified public accountant is to examine a concern's accounting records and supporting data, in certain matters to obtain outside confirmations, and to require and consider supplementary explanations and information from the management and employees, to the extent necessary to enable him to form an opinion as to whether or not the financial statements as submitted present fairly the position and results of periodic operations.

Generally speaking, his function is limited to reporting upon situations, arising out of business transactions that have taken place in the past. In no sense is he an insurer or guarantor. In offering his opinion, the certified public accountant assumes heavy responsibilities. He must be skilled in his professional work and must have made a reasonable examination of the accounts in order to warrant his expression of an opinion. He must state his opinion clearly and unequivocally.

Management itself has the direct responsibility for the maintenance of an adequate and effective system of accounts, for the proper recording of transactions in the books of account and for the safeguarding of the assets of a concern. It is also charged with the primary responsibility to stockholders and to creditors for the substantial accuracy and adequacy of statements of position and operations.

In order to qualify himself to carry out his function the certified public accountant has completed a rigorous course of professional study and training as a background to the essential practical experience he must obtain, for it is only by study, training, and practical experience that he acquires skill in accounting and related matters.

In the ordinary course of his day-to-day practice he encounters a wide range of judgment on the part of management, varying from true objective judgment to the occasional extreme of deliberate misstatement. He is retained to examine and report upon the affairs of a concern because, through his training and experience, he has become not only skilled in accounting and auditing but has acquired the ability and habit of considering dispassionately and independently the facts recorded in books of account or otherwise disclosed by his examination and because, as a result, his opinion provides reasonable assurance that a fair and adequate presentation of pertinent information has been made in the financial statements.

The certified public accountant must also exercise his best judgment in determining the scope of his examination and in deciding whether the interests of stockholders and creditors justify the time and expense involved in the extension of any particular line of inquiry. Experience shows that, with few exceptions, the personnel of business organizations is honest. The discovery of defalcations has not been a primary objective of an examination incident to the issuance of financial statements accompanied by a report and opinion of a certified public accountant, although such discovery has frequently resulted. In a well organized concern the principal reliance for the detection of such irregularities is placed upon the maintenance of an adequate system of accounting records with appropriate internal check and control.

It is the duty of the certified public accountant to satisfy himself that the system of internal check and control is adequate and sufficiently effective to justify reliance thereon. To exhaust the possibility of exposure of all cases of dishonesty or fraud, he would have to examine in detail all transactions. This would entail a prohibitive cost to the great majority of business enterprises—a cost which would pass all bounds of reasonable expectation of benefit or safeguard therefrom, and place an undue burden on industry.

In carrying out his work the certified public accountant must always be on his guard against collusive fraud and be alert in detecting any sign of such collusion. However, on the basis of his examination by tests and checks, he relies upon the integrity of the client's organization unless circumstances are such as to arouse suspicion, in which case he must extend his procedures to determine whether or not such suspicions are justified.

The certified public accountant should not express the opinion that financial statements present fairly the position of the company and the results of its operations, and that they conform to generally accepted accounting principles, when his exceptions are such as to negative the opinion, or when the examination has been less in scope than he considers necessary. In such circumstances, the certified public accountant should limit his report to a statement of his findings and if appropriate his reasons for omitting an expression of opinion.

No certified public accountant should accept an audit engagement so restricted in scope as to make his report and opinion valueless; in other words, an audit engagement where he has not done sufficient work to justify him in forming an opinion. The responsibility as to what constitutes a proper examination rests largely with the individual certified public accountant and has to be decided in each case. As in other professions, the soundness of a decision depends on the character, ability, and experience of the person or persons making such decisions.

In considering financial statements prepared by certified public accountants it should be borne in mind that they are not capable of absolute exactness but rather represent the application of judgment, accounting principles, and convention to certain economic facts and transactions.
