### **Federal Priorities**

#### Accounting in STEM

The profession is advocating for recognition of accounting as part of a Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) curriculum under the Technology field. KyCPA believes that designating accounting as STEM will increase student engagement with the accounting profession.

Legislation will be reintroduced to continue to pursue these goals.

#### Federal Tax Extension "Safe Harbor"

The current rules for filing an extension require time-consuming calculations of the current year tax by April 15 – to avoid incurring penalties. Tax preparers are often putting hours of work into this initial estimation and then a second preparation and review process later. Instead of relying on the current rule of calculating a percentage of the current year tax liability, individuals, trusts, estates, and C corporations would be able to calculate a safe harbor of 125% of the prior year tax ("125% safe harbor") to be paid in by the original due date to avoid the failure to pay and file penalties. Legislation is currently pending in the House, H.R.3566.
