

2020 legislative session wins!

Kentucky Society of CPAs (KyCPA) worked with the:

- **Governor's office to ensure accounting/financial services were deemed essential in the Governor's executive stay at home orders.**
- **General Assembly to get critical language added to SB 150.**
 - Allowed the Kentucky Department of Revenue (DOR) to waive interest and penalties for Kentucky taxpayers
 - Mandated that the Kentucky DOR conform to the federal tax relief- which included extending income tax deadlines
- **General Assembly to have Kentucky adopt the federal partnership audit legislation.**
- **Sales Tax on Professional Services (STOPS) coalition to proactively lobby against sales tax on professional services.**

KyCPA was successful in getting several recommendations added to HB 261, which helped provide clarity on certain tax statuses.

KyCPA advocated to our federal delegation for additional PPP clarification.
